1. Documentation and Maintenance of Records: The cell documented the records of research activities of the faculty of the college.

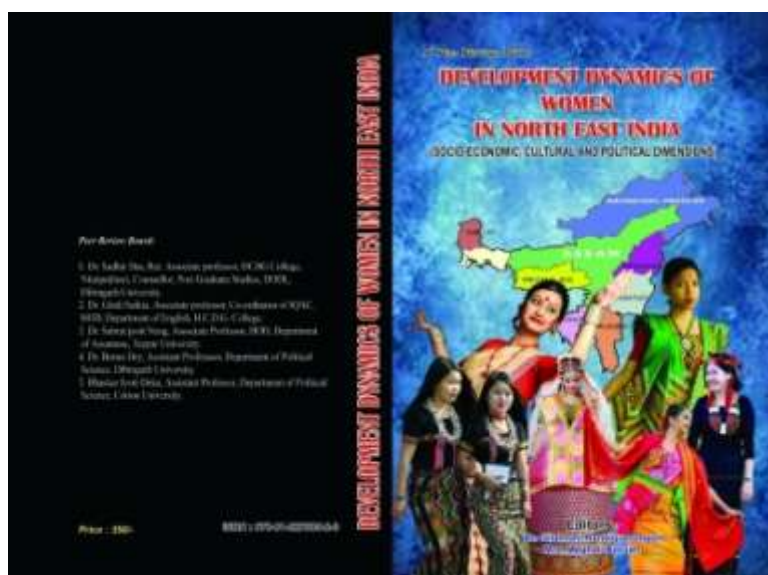
(i) Data on the title of study, name of supervisor, the name of the university and year of degree conferred of PhD and M.Phil.

2. Formulation of Research Policies: The research cell formulate rules, regulations and policies for the utilization of facilities and resources, and make liaison with other stakeholders (institution, organization, government) for innovative plans.

3. Publication of Books: The Cell published one book of research-based articles with Cell for Women Studies and Development and Publication Cell, H.C.D.G. College entitled 'Development Dynamics of Women in North-East in 2021 with ISBN 978-81-927985-2-3. The cell maintains integrity and complies with the ethical codes of research in publishing articles.



4.Capacity Building: Research cells play a role in building the capacity of students and teachers to undertake various contemporary research problems. The cell encourages teachers to present research-based papers at National and International Conferences/Seminars, to publish research-based papers in leading journals that have good impact factors, Scopus Indexed, Web of Science and UGC-CARE recognized journals, to undertake UGC sponsored Research Projects in the area of their specialization and also encourage teachers to organize National and International Conferences/Seminars, Workshops, training/internship and group discussion.

5. Resource Mobilization: The research cell creates its own fund for the facilitation of department projects, and field study, organizes seminars and published books for the students. It manages the grants and funds of the cell.

The students of the 6th semester of the Education and English department have done a community visit projecton ‘Gender Parity’ especially emphasising the changes in girls and women regarding social participation and educationof Deori community people at Bargaon, Panidehingon 1st January, 2022. The projects were supervised and assisted by teachers of the department.

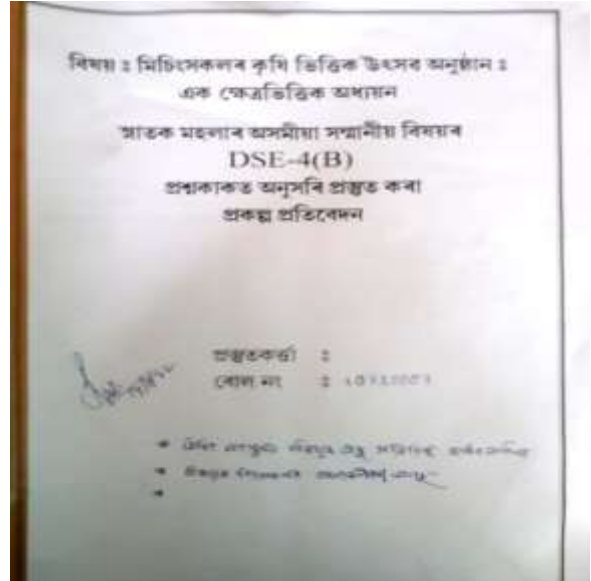
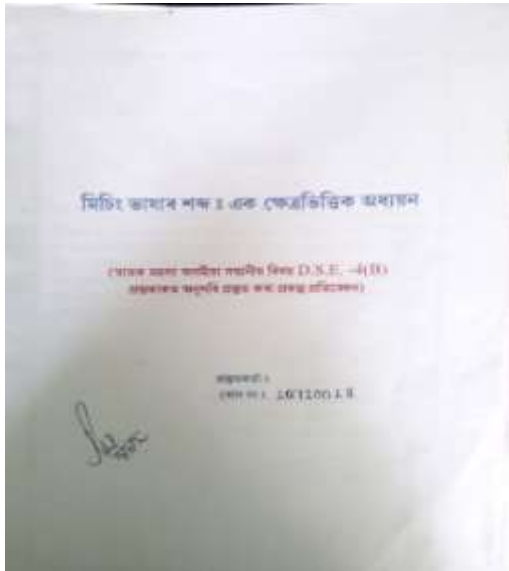
