This MoU is intended only to provide a framework for separate and formal written agreements between the 'Parties' with regard to particular exchange endeavors. In this context, this MoU shall remain in place until:

- 6.1 Suspended by such a formal written agreement(s).
- 6.2 Terminated by either 'Party' upon written information /notice of not less than Ninety (90) days or
- 6.3 At the least, Three (3) years from the execution of the same, unless the 'Parties' mentally agree in writing to extend the same.

7. Coordination Committee

- (f) The Receiving Institution will have the right to remove any student from the Program. In this instance, the Receiving Institution will provide written notification to the Home Institution. The Home Institution will comply with the request for removal immediately.
- 4.3 Students Participation in Extension Program/Activity: Students may participate in extension program/activity under a super visor of faculty member from willing Institution in between two 'Institutions'. The program may include under per view of cultural, environmental, and literary and sports etc. The Home Institution will arrange for performing the events and expenditure.
