### H.C.D.G. College Central Library



The H.C.D.G. College Central Library is a partially automated using SOUL 2.0 integrated library management software since 2014. The central library provides OPAC (Online Public Access Catalogue) facility for the user community. They can able to search the database by author, title classification number, and subject to know the availability of the books by using OPAC. The bookshelves are arranged departmental wise and books are arranged subject-wise. The books were classified using the Dewy Decimal Classification Scheme (DDC) 21st edition. The central library has various sections like periodical, reference, circulation, E-resource, reprography section etc. The college library had a reading room with a 50 seating capacity for the library users. The library is open from 10 AM to 4 PM on all working days.

The library has a membership of the National Library and Information Services Infrastructure for Scholarly Content (N-LIST), INFLIBNET Centre, Gandhinagar, Gujarat. The N-LIST provides 6000+ e-journals and 199500+ e-books for member institutions.

The central library has established an Institutional Repository in the year 2019. An Institutional Repository is an archive for acquiring, preserving and disseminating digital copies of the intellectual output of an institution.

The library has Book Bank facility that provides free books to economically backward but meritorious students.

### ICT enabled Classrooms

The H.C.D.G. College has ICT enabled classrooms well equipped with digital teaching aids. There are Smart Boards, Interactive Smart Boards, Overhead projectors, uninterrupted power supply, better sitting arrangements etc.

### Conference Hall and Auditorium



The College has one conference hall with video conferencing facility. It has a sitting capacity of 60 people. The College has a spacious and well-staged auditorium within the campus having a seat capacity of 300 hundred people. All the institutional, curricular, co-curricular and cultural functions are held in the auditorium throughout the year.

### Open Stage



The college has an open stage donated by the Alumni Association, H.C.D.G. College to organize various cultural programmes. Every year the college celebrates cultural festivals of the region.

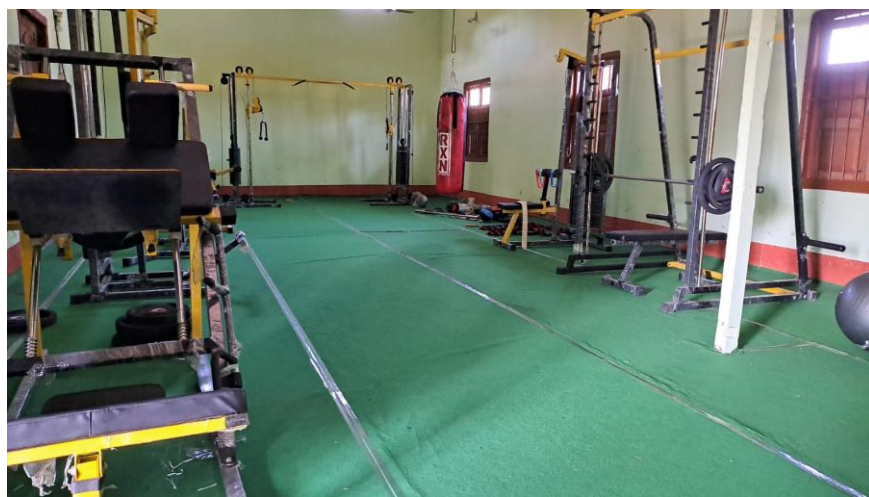
### Girls' Hostel



The H.C.D.G. College has a well-furnished hostel for the girl students within the campus with a capacity for 32 students. The Warden's hostel is attached with the main hostel. It is secure with boundaries in all four sides and is under CCTV surveillance. The hostel has 24 hrs. running water supply with separate aquaguard facility for pure drinking water installed in the dining area. There is inverter installed in the hostel to ensure 24 hrs. uninterrupted power supply. The hostel has also a small library of its own available for the hostellers.

### Gymnasium





The H.C.D.G. College has a well-furnished gymnasium for both staff and students.

### Canteen



The college canteen provides refreshment for the college student and staff at a subsidized rate inside the campus.

### Laboratories

The College has sophisticated Computer Laboratory with necessary facilities available for students and staffs. The college also has a psychology laboratory for the practical examinations of the department of Education.

### Drinking Water

Purified drinking water facilities are available for all inside the college campus. Separate water taps are installed in necessary places for other purposes.

### Xerox Point

The facility in the Library provides photocopy facility of study materials and other documents for the students and staff at a subsidized rate.

### Games and Sports

The College has facilities for both indoor and outdoor games. Volleyball court and badminton court are there inside the college campus.

### Yoga and Meditation Centre

To ensure both physical and mental wellness the students are encouraged to practice yoga regularly. The college has a Yoga Centre. The college has signed MoU with the Brahma Kumari Retreat Centre, Demow branch. The college has conducted certificate course on Yoga and Meditation for the students in collaboration with the centre.

#### NCC:

The NCC Unit of H.C.D.G. College was formed on 9th October, 2021 in the presence of Lieutenant Commander Rajesh Bhujel, Commanding Officer, 49 Assam Naval Unit, Sivasagar, Assam. This day is observed as the 'Raising Day' of NCC Unit in our college. The present strength of the cadets is 30 including both 1st and 2nd year cadets and the sanctioned strength of cadets is 50, which is expected to be achieved by the end of the training year 2023-24. The NCC Unit of the College presently functions with 49 Assam Naval Unit, NCC, Sivasagar.

#### NSS:

H.C.D.G. College provides opportunity to students to join its unit of National Service Scheme (NSS). The students participate in various programmes and camps the unit conducts.
