

Report on
New India Literacy Programme- NLIP
At HCDG College, Nitaipukhuri
August 2025 to February 2026

A govt. scheme of adult literacy under ULLAS - Nav Bharat Saaksharata Karyakram (New India literacy Programme- NLIP) 2025 was undertaken by Adult education department, for understanding lifelong learning for all in society. It aims to make India 100 percent literate in alignment with the National Education Policy 2020. It targets adults aged 15 and above from all background. The tagline of the programme is 'Jan Jan Saakshar'.

Training programme: A one day Training programme of Surveyor's and Volunteer Teacher's on New India Literacy programme was organized by District Literacy Mission Authority, Sivasagar on 4th September 2025 at Conference hall-I of HCDG College. Mr. Gobin Borah, APO, Adult Education department, Sivasagar, Mr. Puspaprohlad Gogoi, Assistant teacher, Hukanpukhuri High School, Demow as Master trainer, Assistant Coordinator of the scheme Sri Radhagobinda Hazarika, trainer cum Asst. coordinator Ms. Imon Gogoi, Mr. Munna Sonowal and Ms. Pragma Phukan attended the meeting. The undergraduate students of the college attended the programme. They participated in a rally on 4th September 2025 organized by NILP under Sivasagar District Literacy Mission Authority in occasion of weeklong programme of World Literacy Day during 2nd September to 8th September 2025.

Dr. Leena Dutta, Assistant Professor, Department of Education was appointed as Coordinator of the college for the scheme. She participated in a programme on NILP organized by Office of the District commission, Sivasagar.

The survey: The willing students registered themselves as surveyor in the official ULLAS portal. 7 students of undergraduate programme registered as surveyor. The coordinator was also accessed in the portal. The students surveyed in their selected area and gathered the name of illiterate adults aged 15 and above who missed formal schooling. The names of illiterates were registered as learner in the portal attached with a primary school of nearby area. A total number of 108 learners were found by the surveyors.

The learning process: A book entitled 'Ullas' was provided to each learner as learning material. The programme was implemented in hybrid mode. Classes were held time to time in nearby schools. The students can learn in their mother language.

The examination: An Assessment test is conducted to evaluate the basic reading, writing and math skills of learners. The learners were evaluated on 8th February 2026 under the 5th Foundation Literacy and Numeracy Assessment Test (FLNAT) 2025. The test is administered for 20 marks of three hours duration distributing 50 marks for reading, 50 marks for writing and 50 marks for numeracy. The mark sheet cum literacy certificates were issued to qualified adults after declaration of results by the School Education and Literacy Department and National Institute of Open Schooling of India.
